EV Drive mode: Electric Power only




Twin motors power all four wheels using electricity form the lithiumion battery Series Hybrid Mode: Electric Power + Engine Assistance



The petrol engine operates as a generator supplying electricity to the battery which in turn powers the motors. This is highly efficient use of fuel and occurs when the battery charge falls below a predetermined level or when more powerful performance is required (when overtaking or climbing a hill)

Parallel Hybrid Mode: Engine Power + Motor assistance



The petrol engine provides most of the power, with assistance from the motors when required. This is only used for high-speed motoring.

Charge or Save – In battery charge mode, when the engine is engaged it continually charges the battery. In Battery Save mode the engine will maintain the charge you have when it is engaged allowing you the optimum battery charge for later
